Half year report for Q1 and Q2, 2006

1. Business Activities

During the year the company has continued its policy of outsourcing as much of its normal functions as possible. Today the production, blending, packaging and shipping has been outsourced to different sub-suppliers across Europe.

Sales for the period have been +223% compared to the same period 2005.

In August/September we will launch a new product on the market, AKTIV Meal/Drink™, the product will be launched on the existing markets. With this product we believe that we have a major chance on getting some serious movement on the main European markets such as UK, Germany and Italy.

Major customers, across Europe, have been signed for keeping stock and generating sales from August and onwards, however none of these customers will be disclosed until we actually have invoiced sales to present.

Sales from the web shop at www.getAktiv.com is proceeding.

The process which is applied to barley has been tried on oats, with the same remarkable results when it comes to the molecule weight of the beta-glucans.

Besides the improved sales with AKTIV™ products, the work of moving AKTIVATED BARLEY™ as a ingrediance with other food stuff producing companies continues, however this path is much more time consuming and some major results cannot be expected until Q4 at the earliest.

The different segments of the market include companies within bread, snacks, health foods and drinks. Some of the potential customers are on the top-10 list worldwide in size.

2. Financial Statement

The financial situation of the company continues to be a concern; however with the signed contracts for deliveries starting August, 2006, the situation should slowly start to change.

3. Working environment

The working environment is satisfactory and the company cannot report any work related accidents.

4. Environmental issues

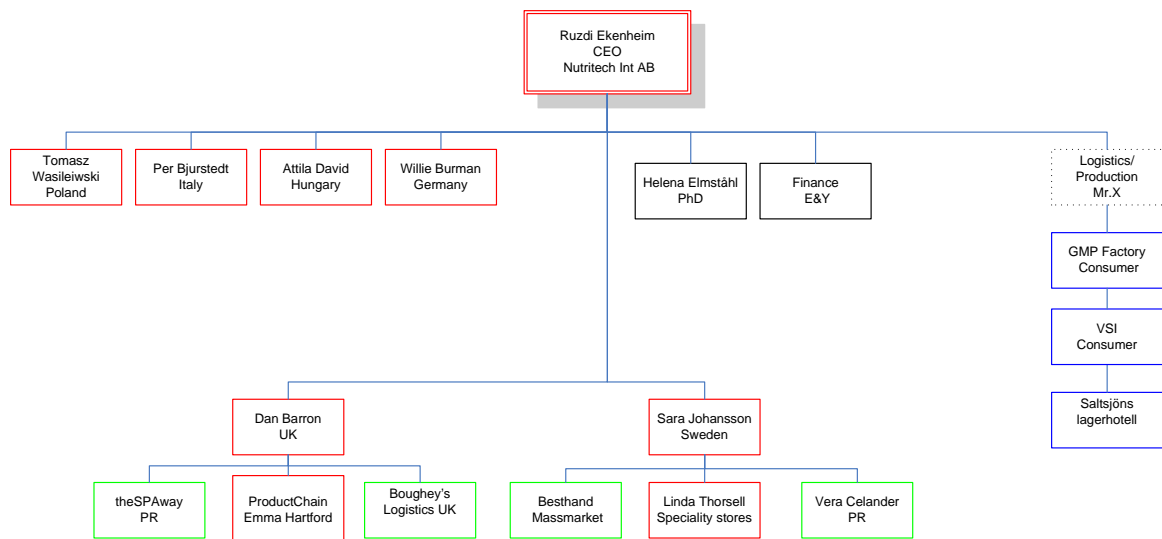
The company is not handling any waste, nor is it involved in any handling of any hazardous material.
